Morning Session: CREATIVE NATURE & TRAVEL PHOTOGRAPHY. by Rick Sammon, www.ricksammon.com

Rick Sammon has published 27 books, including his latest trio: "Rick Sammon's Travel and Nature Photography," "Rick Sammon.s Complete Guide to Digital Photography" and "I dea to I mage." Rick is the host of the Digital Photography Workshop on the Do I t Yourself (DI Y) network and a guest host of the Canon Photo Safari on the Outdoor Life Network. He writes for PCPhoto, Outdoor Photographer, Shutterbug and Layers magazine. Rick has produced seven interactive DVD.s for photographers and Adobe Photoshop/Photoshop Elements users for rickspixelmagic.com, an ecommerce site that he co-founded. Each year, Rick travels the globe in search of new images and gives more than a dozen photography workshops and presentations around the world. He.s been to more than 100 destinations on the planet, including the Arctic, Antarctica, Africa, Bhutan, Brazil, Galapagos, India, Indonesia, Nepal and Papua New Guinea. Rick is also the author of the Canon Digital Rebel XT lessons on the Canon Digital Learning Center and is a Canon Explorer of Light. He is also a member of the Explorers Club.
