NJFCC CITATION


The New Jersey Federation of Camera Clubs presents an honor, the NJFCC Citation, and has established the policy of awarding public recognition to individuals who have made major contributions to the advancement of the art and science of photography. This award is the highest individual honor bestowed by the Federation.

The Citation Committee consists of Nick Palmieri, Chair; George Hall, NJFC; and John Sandstedt, NJFC.

To nominate a candidate two forms must be completed. The first, the Proposer's Form, presents the accomplishments of the nominee as describe by the Proposer. The second, the Endorser's Form, is an independent endorsement of the nominee by another party.

Completed nomination documents must be sent to Nick Palmieri at docnick@comcast.net. The deadline for receipt of the Proposer's Application and Endorser's Forms is February 15, 2014.

NOTES FROM THE PRINT CHAIRMAN

Eric Mayr

I would like to thank all those clubs who stepped up to participate in the new, revised print contest. Your work is incredible and a pleasure to look at. That being said, there are a few issues that need to be addressed in order to not be disqualified in future contests.

Let's address the first major issue, the difference between Tops in NJ and the Spring and Fall Competitions. Tops reflects each maker's best work; however the print competition is divided into two subgroups, that is, monochrome and color. The definition of monochrome is a single toned image such as white, black or sepia, with no additional accent color. If a monochrome print has an accent color it must be entered as a color print. So each maker is allowed to submit their best color print and their best monochrome print.

In the Spring and Fall Competitions, each maker is allowed to submit three color prints and three monochrome prints. The total number of entries allowed per club for the Spring and Fall is 24; the total for tops is unlimited. Clubs are allowed to decide how they will reach their total number of allowed prints.

The next issue is mounting. All entries must be attached to one of the following materials: mat board or foam core. What is not allowed is oak tag, pizza boxes, shirt cardboard, loose prints, prints attached to window mats. The boards can be purchased at your local art store. For ease in cutting, I am suggesting that you purchase two ply board.

Prints can be attached to its mounting board with one of the following materials: Mounting tissue which can be used in a mounting press. There are two kinds: one for color prints, one for monochrome. They are not interchangeable as they each have their own melting temperature. For ink jet prints, however, mounting spray may be used. There are two kinds: repositionable and non-repositionable. Be forewarned that non-repositionable is the harder one to work with. That is, you need to get it right the first time - no do overs. These sprays can be purchased at your local art store.

You can also wet mount you're prints with wet mounting glue also available at your local art store.

When mounting prints the boards and the prints need to be dry. Do not mount on high humidity days or, if you choose to, dry your boards in a hot mount press before beginning work. If the board is wet the print will come off the board when it dries. You should test to see if the print is firmly attached by gently bending the mount. Prints not firmly attached will pop off.

To those of you doing archival work, acid free, two ply museum board should be your choice.

On another note each print competition is an open competition. No DVD is required.

A word to club Print Chairpersons: Your job is to make sure your entries follow the rules. I do not like to disqualify work. Contact me with your ideas and concerns. I appreciate your input and will get back to you.
